



### Call for Papers!

***Visual Culture & Gender (VCG)* is an international, freely accessed, online journal available @ <http://vcg.emitto.net/>. ISSN #1936-1912**

The journal's purpose is to encourage and promote an understanding of how visual culture constructs gender in context with representations of race, age, sexuality, social units, (dis)ability and social class, and to promote international dialogue about visual culture and gender. *VCG* is also concerned with the learning and teaching processes and/or practices used to expose culturally learned meanings and power relations that surround the creation, consumption, valuing, and dissemination of images, and involves issues of equity and social justice in the learning, teaching, and practice of art.

*Visual Culture & Gender* is the first multimedia online journal in the field of art education and has an established international review board of feminist scholars in art education, and in media, African, visual culture, queer theory, and women's studies. The journal is included in the following databases: Proquest ARTbibliographies Modern; Feminist Periodicals; Wilson Database; CNKI SCHOLAR; and EBSCO.

**Submission of Manuscripts:** November 15 is the deadline for submission of articles, images, and reviews of books, video/films, performance/actions, Web sites, visual culture, and exhibitions for an annual publication each autumn since 2006. *VCG* will consider for publication manuscripts that address gender issues in the context of visual culture and arts education. To be considered, manuscripts should be no more than 5000 words in length with an abstract of 150 words, as well as 5-8 keywords. Images are encouraged with manuscripts and should be sent in digital format (jpg, gif, or png) with copyright permission provided. Visual research is encouraged but images must be accompanied by text. Original manuscripts should be prepared according to the APA (6th edition) style. Include in a cover letter that the manuscript is original, not previously published, and not under consideration elsewhere. Please place your name only in the accompanying cover letter and not in the manuscript to facilitate anonymous review. Submit the manuscript with .doc or .docx extension by uploading at the "Submissions" hyperlink (see menu option on the leftside) at <http://vcg.emitto.net/>.
